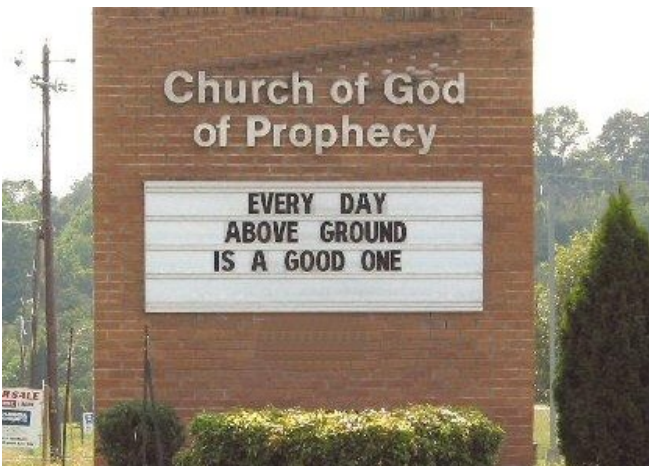
Great teamwork – thanks be to God!
